The Jefferson Planning Board will hold a **SECOND public hearing ONLY if substantive language changes have been made since the first hearing on January 18** to again receive comments about proposed changes to the town's Land Use Ordinance.

- (1) A change to Article III, Section 2A – Permitted Uses by Special Exception:  
To add the word “short-term rentals” and the word “campgrounds” to the list of Special Exceptions.
- (2) A change to Article III, Section 4 - Definitions:  
To add the definitions of “Recreational Vehicle (RV)”, “Campground”, and Short-Term Rental”.
- (3) To add a new to Article III, Section 5:  
Recreational Vehicle occupancy outside of approved campgrounds.
- (4) A change to Article V, Section 8 – Administration and Enforcement - Building Codes:  
To add two new paragraphs B and C.
- (5) A change to Article VI, Section 1 – Administration and Enforcement, Approvals:  
To change wording in paragraphs A, B, and D, delete paragraph C, and add a new paragraph E.
