

TOWN OF JEFFERSON  
BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
March 24, 2014

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday March 24, 2014 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Thomas Brady, Chairman and Kevin Meehan members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen, Mark Dubois, Highway Foreman

Thomas Brady opened the regular meeting at 7:05 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed.

Kevin Meehan made a motion to accept the minutes of the March 17, 2014 Selectmen meeting as amended(spelling error). Tom seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Jessica Pelliter of Twin Mountain has asked if they could rent the Town Hall on March 29. It has been the practice to rent the hall to residents. Linda asked if the Board would allow rental of the hall to a nonresident. Tom asked if there was a written policy regarding the rental of the hall. No. Kevin made a motion to allow the rental of the hall to a nonresident. Tom seconded the motion stating that a written policy should be adopted. The motion carries.

Mark Dubois was in to present his work schedule for road maintenance for the year. Mark said that if the paving is going to be done on Israels River Road that additional work will have to be done. It is possible that the sweeper will have to be brought back to sweep the road. There are several culverts that need to be replaced. Mark presented the Board with an outline of the work that he has planned for the summer as well as the work he completed in 2013. Mark stated that one culvert on the Turnpike has been damaged by something and has to be replaced by the McCreedy farm. On the Ingerson Road there are two culverts that need to be replaced. Tom asked where. Mark said one by the Pond Safety Road. On the Valley Road they are going to do some ditching between the road and the rail bed. Hopefully they can get the water to flow to the culvert below where it comes under the rail bed. Kevin asked what the length of road was that needed to be raised. About 1500-feet and it will take about 80-yards of gravel to raise the road. There is some brush along the edge of the tracks that should be cut back. On the Ingerson Road most of the brush has been cleaned up. There is a section from the cemetery back to bridge that needs some cutting.

Mark asked the Board if there was any projects that they wanted him to do this year. If they do he said just to let him know and they could show him what they wanted.

There were two elderly exemption applications submitted. The application of Thomas and Karla Taylor was approved. Kevin asked about the application for Louis Daigle as he is not the property owner. Mr. Daigle has life tenancy therefore he is entitled to the exemption if he qualifies. Mr. Daigles application was approved.

Linda had prepared a letter to be sent to Mr. James Lewis. The letter is stating that we are waiting for the final driveway approval. Also Mr. Lewis is being asked about the vehicles that are parked at the entrance of the property.

The Board decided at the suggestion of the family to donate \$50 to the Lancaster Community Cupboard and Kitchen in memory of Carroll Ingerson.

Kevin made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Tom seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:10 pm.
