

TOWN OF JEFFERSON  
BOARD OF SELECTMEN  
April 20, 2015

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday April 20, 2015 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Acting Chair and Thomas Brady members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen; Mark Dubois, Highway Foreman

Kevin Meehan opened the regular meeting at 7:08 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. The warrants were signed.

Tom Brady made a motion to accept the minutes of the April 13, 2015 Selectmen meeting as written. Kevin Meehan seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Mark Dubois reported that the roads are holding up good the frost in coming slow. Mark said that they got the hole up by Cooks fixed. Up on Starr King Road Mark thinks that they may have to change a culvert by the Ward house. The drainage from most of the houses on Cottage Road is running out into the road which causes the problems with the road.

The work that was done last year on the Whipple Road has held up good there haven't been any mud holes yet.

Mark said that he would be changing the oil and filters on the grader this week.

Rodney Boulde has started picking roadsides this week. Mark asked if Rebecca Kenison could be hired to help do the roadsides and help Rodney with some of the cemetery work. Steve Noyes has said that he does not want to do any mowing this year. Mark stated that no one else seems to want to do the work. The Selectmen approved hiring Rebecca Kenison at \$8.00 an hour.

Tom reported that he attended the eviction hearing for Allen and Melissa Phillips. The eviction notice did not show how it was served. The judge has taken the case under advisement. What this could mean is that the process will have to start over again with a new notice being served. Attorney Whitley and Tom spoke with Mr. and Mrs. Phillips, they just said that they could not afford to make the payments as set forth by the Town. Mr. Phillips is unemployed and Mrs. Phillips work is not regular.

The court findings was received today which states that because there was no proof that the notice was served and the defendants deny that they were noticed the finding is awarded to the defendant.

The Selectmen signed a new eviction notices. The notices will be taken to the Sheriffs Office for service.

DES has returned the yearly Transfer Station report because it was not signed by the Selectmen. On the report it states that the report is to be signed by the Selectmen or appointed representative. Kevin

signed the report. Tom suggested and made the motion that a letter be sent to DES stating that Linda Cushman as assistant to the selectmen is the appointed representative for the Board. Kevin seconded the motion. Motion carries. Kevin stated that he would come into the office to sign the letter when it was ready.

Chris Milligan had contacted the Fire Marshal's office regarding doing the inspection for the Bellevue Barn at the Carlisle Place. A letter to the Fire Marshal requesting their departments assistance on this project along with all the in house permits needs to be submitted to the Fire Marshal. The Selectmen signed a letter requesting the Fire Marshal's assistance.

The next meeting will be April 27, 2015, at 7:00 pm.

Tom made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Kevin seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:45 pm.
