

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN
October 6, 2014

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday October 6, 2014 at 7:05 pm.

PRESENT: Thomas Brady, Chairman, and Kevin Meehan members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen, Alan & Melissa Phillips

Thomas Brady opened the regular meeting at 7:08 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. The warrants were signed and bills approved for payment.

Kevin Meehan made a motion to accept the minutes of the September 29, 2014 Selectmen minutes correcting a spelling error. Tom Brady seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Linda Cushman reported that Jeff Wiseman has agreed to take the appointment to the North Country Oil Sill Preparedness.

Alan and Melissa Phillips were in to discuss with the Selectmen their repayment of property taxes owed on their property. Mr. Phillips said that they can not make the thousand dollar payment as required. He said that one third of that has been paid. Kevin told Mr. Phillips that regular payments have to be made. They said that it is hard getting caught up. They have a vehicle that needs repairs and with winter approaching. Mrs. Phillips said that they thought that when they paid the \$2000 that the payments would be reduced. When that payment was made it only brought the payment schedule current. Tom stated that they have to make the payments as agreed. We can not extend this. The Town does not want to take the property. The biggest issue is that communication with the Board has to be kept and you have to show that your are making an effort to make your payments as agreed.

Kevin asked if an electrician had checked the Library yet to check the usage. Linda said that Davis Electric will hopefully get to it this week.

Linda said that she had gotten quotes for folding chairs that range from \$15 to \$20 each. WB Mason had quoted \$90 for 4. The first thing that needs to be decided is do you want vinyl or cloth if a padded chair is to be purchased.

There has been no news on the wetland permit for the bridge.

Tom asked if any roadside mowing was being done. Yes, the Whipple Road and Turnpike have been done. Tom asked if the Ingerson Road was going to be done. Linda will check with Mark Dubois.

Kevin asked to check and find out what the cost would be to repair the wall at the Transfer Station.

Linda said that she was waiting to get a quote on a new container for the glass. Norman had asked to

have Mark look at the old container that is at the Transfer Station to see if it could be used for the glass.

The next meeting will be October 20, 2014.

Kevin made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Tom seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:00 pm.
