

TOWN OF JEFFERSON  
SELECTBOARD

December 5, 2016

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday December 5, 2016 at 6: 30 pm

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chair, and Tom Brady, and Cindy Silver, members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen, Terri Larcomb, Treasurer;

Kevin Meehan opened the regular meeting at 6:35 pm. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week. The Highway and Transfer Station report was reviewed. The warrants were signed. Terri Larcomb was in to pickup signed warrants and sign checks.

Cindy Silver made a motion to accept the minutes of the November 28, 2016 Select Board meeting as written. Tom Brady seconded the motion. Motion carries.

GovConnection has quoted \$549.00 for a Lenovo computer that will meet the DMV specs for the Town Clerk. In purchasing a Town owned computer it will make IT work more accessible. The computer that is being used now is owned by the State and any IT work has to be done through the State. The Select Board approved the purchase of a new computer for the Town Clerk.

The Select Board discussed the possible purchase of a new tanker as requested by the Fire Department. Linda was asked to find out what the rate and payment would be on \$200,000 for a period of 10 or 15 years.

Pistol permits were signed for J Mello and L Grover.

The water has been connected. The well is 500-feet with 1.25 gallon per minute at a cost of \$7554, not including the pump. Once the system is flushed a water sample will be taken to Concord. A well radii release form was signed and will be recorded at the Registry of Deeds. This is required because of the location of the well.

Cindy Silver said that Don Saucier had called her home about the Town changing the snow machine trail that goes on Chambers Road. Mr. Saucier was told that he should attend a Board meeting to discuss this issue. The Town does not establish the trails.

The compensation of Barry Nelson for the additional work for the Fire Department was discussed. The Board asked that Chris Milligan to attend the December 12<sup>th</sup> meeting to answer some questions. It was asked to see the minutes from where Chief Milligan had presented the plan to have Mr. Nelson assist in fire inspections.

The budget was reviewed. Cindy said that she would like some more detail as to what the miscellaneous expenses were for 2015.

Charlie Bond had asked if long term installation of housing trailers were allowed on undubdivided lots which also have a permanent housing structure and what how blackwater is disposed. The Board said that only one dwelling is allowed and that all waste water has to be properly disposed of.

The next meeting will be December 12, 2016 at 6:30 pm

Cindy made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Tom seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 7:20 pm.
