

TOWN OF JEFFERSON
BOARD OF SELECTMEN

June 3, 2013

The regular meeting of the Board of Selectmen for the Town of Jefferson was held at the Selectmen Office Monday June 3, 2013 at 7:00 pm.

PRESENT: Kevin Meehan, Chairman and Tom Brady and Norman Brown members comprising a quorum of the Board.

OTHERS PRESENT: Linda Cushman, Assistant to Selectmen; Mark Dubois, Road Foreman; Chris Milligan, Fire Chief, Terri Larcomb, Treasurer

Kevin Meehan opened the regular meeting at 7:10. The Board reviewed and approved the bills for payment next week and signed the warrants. The Highway Department report was reviewed. The warrants were signed. Terri Larcomb was in to sign checks and pick up warrants.

Norman Brown made a motion to accept the minutes of the May 20, 2013 Selectmen Meeting minutes as written. Tom Brady seconded the motion. Motion carries.

Linda Cushman stated that Matthew of Holden Engineering & Surveying would like to make a presentation at the next meeting on some options that his company has developed for replacing the Chambers Road bridge. The State has listed this bridge as deficient in need of repair. Norman asked if it would be possible to get the information prior to the 17th meeting. He said that it would be productive to know what is to be presented rather than trying to review the information during the presentation. Linda will check.

The contract from Whitco/McCormack to do the engraving at the Honor Roll was signed in the amount of \$350.

Mark Dubois reported that they had hauled gravel to the Turnpike Road and done the entrances at Whipple Road and Jason Avenue. Tom Brady said that some ledge pac should be applied at the approaches to the bridge on the Ingerson Road. It was asked if NH DOT had responded to the letter regarding replacing the apron on the Ingerson Road. No, Norman said that he would stop up to the office.

Mark said that he would like to purchase some new cutting edges for the grader. He said that he thought that the last time the edges were bought they cost \$2500. Norman asked if he had checked to see where the State has purchased cutting edges. Chris Milligan said the State does not purchase the carbide edges. Mark stated that the steel edges are cheaper, however the need to be changed just about after every use. Mark was told to check pricing before ordering.

Chris Milligan said that their trip to Morgan/Olsen was beneficial. The manager suggested that the interior be done by the Town after delivery. The wall would be covered with insulation and plywood, if they do it it is a 40% markup. The chassis should be delivered by the end of this week to Morgan/Olsen. Morgan/Olsen may be interested in the old van because it is original and one that they built in 1977.

Chris told the Board that examples of the diamond rail and the traditional black fence that is being quoted for the cemetery could be seen in North Conway at the Saco River Campground and NC Screen Printing just over the covered bridge. Norman asked if Chris had gotten the cost to do all the cleaning of the stones in Riverton. No, Chris said that he would get in touch with John Hanks this week.

Tom made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Norman seconded the motion. The motion carries.

Being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:15 pm.
