

Town of Jefferson
Select Board Meeting
November 01, 2021
Jefferson Community Center

The meeting was called to order at 7:03 p.m. by Selectman Kevin Meehan with Norman Brown and Wendy Wells present. 6 public attendants.

The pledge of Allegiance was recited to salute the flag.

The week's accounts payable and payroll expenditures were signed and approved.

Public input.

Nancy Decourcey, Donald Crocker and Laura Crocker were in attendance to speak in regards to the adjacent property to them both at 1369 Presidential Highway, owned by Patricia Lovely. They commented to their concerns of ongoing activity that could be in violation of state and local laws. At this time a preliminary building permit has been submitted. It was encouraged by the selectmen to keep in contact with the owner and to call state law enforcement for additional support.

Building permits and additional correspondence were reviewed.

Selectman Norman Brown made a motion to deny a building permit submitted for 1369 Presidential Highway on the grounds that the setback requirements have not been met. Selectman Kevin Meehan seconded this motion and with no discussion the motion was passed unanimously.

Selectman Norman Brown made a motion to approve the contract for Wifi, data and phone communications from Consolidated. Selectman Kevin Meehan seconded this motion and with no discussion the motion was passed unanimously.

The upfront costs of the Consolidated project will be split to an 80% Town responsibility and a 20% Library responsibility, this would also apply to the monthly costs. If monies are received from the American Rescue Fund it will go to defray some of the expense.

Selectman Norman Brown advised of no meeting next week as 2 select people will be absent.

Selectman Norman Brown made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 8:19 p.m., Selectman Kevin Meehan seconded this motion and with no discussion the motion passed unanimously.
