Select Board Chair Norman Brown followed up with the Highway Department about the lighting for the salt shed. Mike Kenison stated that nothing has been done yet. Select Board Chair would like Mike to contact Fred Davis or Royal Electric to get lights put in before winter. Mike Kenison let the Select Board know that they need more orange cones. The Select Board would like Mike to get as many cones as the Highway Department needs.


Jimmey Howland- Transfer Station: Only issue is with the metal container. When it is empty it is being dropped too far out and the residents are having a hard time with getting items into the container. Jimmey let the Select Board know that he and Mike have had conversations with Presby and the driver is still causing the issue. Select Board Chair Norman Brown would like Amanda to get him the number and contact person for Presby Recycling so that he can have a conversation with them to resolve the issue.

David Savage- FD: Wanted the Select Board to know that the Fire Department has received their lightweight gear for motor vehicle accidents and forest fires. The FD also upgraded lights on all helmets, packs, & trucks. They are looking to upgrade their cones. Select Board Chair Norman Brown stated that if the cones that they are looking to get rid of are in good condition give them to the Highway Dept. when new cones are ordered and arrive.

Liz Milligan- EMS: Reported that EMS is good. They have received new equipment and their new polo shirts with Jefferson EMS and their names on them. They need to order one more mobile AED. The Select Board told her to get it ordered. They started training with Weeks Medical on Narcan use and NORPAK is working on rehab trailers to be at all fires.
